On behalf of the Ministry of Labor, Social Affairs and Social Services, I wish to thank you for applying to our official governmental program: VOIS – Volunteer in Israel!

Volunteering in Israel is a wonderful way to engage with the local culture and make a real change in people's lives. Come join the 1000 volunteers who come each year from 45 countries to volunteer in VOIS social service placements in Israel. VOIS offers 100 different placements, from north to south, for children and adults with autism, physical and cognitive disabilities, youth at-risk, women at-risk, elderly, and Holocaust survivors.

Volunteers support staff in daily routine, assist in creative & occupational workshops, help in paramedical treatment, give one-on-one personal attention, and share their own skills and ideas. Volunteers get accommodation, allowance, meals, laundry, transportation, trips, Hebrew classes, insurance (covering work accidents), mentorship, professional training, official certificate, and a volunteer visa (conditions may vary from placement to placement).

Volunteers must be above 18 years old, have conversational English, assist 35 hours per week for 6-12 months, and purchase their own flight ticket.

3. Form 3: Volunteer's health declaration – attached.
4. Health insurance (contact us to know of local insurance options)

7. Color passport scan (valid for at least for 12 months)
8. 2 Recommendations
